TOURNAMENT HIGHLIGHTS

Youth

Arabella Alegre tossed her career high game of 215 and added games of 180 & 186 the first three games of qualifying for her career high set of 581. She entered the tournament with a 125 average and rolled 754 for the four games of qualifying, a 189 average.

Owen Hine tossed his career high game the fourth game of qualifying, a 154. Then, in the stepladder finals, he rolled another career high, a 172 game.

Trenten Spencer entered the tournament with a 148 average and rolled 692 for the four qualifying games, a 173 average.

Eric "Kevin" Reedy entered the tournament with a 174 average and rolled 805 for the four qualifying games, a 201 average.
